

# **THAI GOLFERS ASSOCIATION IN AMERICA**

## **BYLAWS**

### **ARTICLE I ORGANIZATION**

- SECTION 1. The name by which this Corporation shall be known is the Thai Golfers Association in America, (TGAA).
- SECTION 2. The TGAA is a non-profit Corporation organized and operated exclusively for scientific, charitable and educational purposes as specified herein.
- SECTION 3. The National headquarters of the TGAA shall be located at 716 Ritchie Avenue, Silver Spring, Maryland 20910. It can be relocated as member requested and approve by Board of Director at the annual meeting.

### **ARTICLE II MEMBERSHIP**

- SECTION 1. Membership in TGAA is open to all golf organizations and any association who interests, supports the goals and objective of TGAA
- SECTION 2. Membership dues in the amount of \$ 100 per organization due at the annual meeting.

### **ARTICLE III BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

- SECTION 1. National:
- The activities and affairs of the TGAA shall be managed by or under the direction of a Board of Directors:
- A. The National board of Directors shall have not less than 9 and not more than 20.
  - B. The number of Directors may increase or decrease by action of the Board of Directors at the annual meeting..
- SECTION 2. The annual meeting on Saturday night will be elected the President. Then the president must appoint BOD with in 15 days.
- A. Term of Directors will be for one year from the annual meeting.

- B. Any vacancies in the board member positions indicated above must be replaced within 15 days.
- SECTION 3 The removal of a Director with or without cause may be effected by a majority of the BOD at the annual meeting.

### **ARTICLE III MEETINGS**

- SECTION 1. There shall be an annual meeting of TGAA on Saturday night before Sunday tournament at the place of BOD agreed.

### **ARTICLE IV OFFICERS AND BOARD OF DIRECTORS**

- SECTION 1 The officers consisting of Vice president, Treasurer, Secretary and others Board of Directors will appoint by the President.
- A. The officers of TGAA shall have such powers and duties as generally pertain to their respective offices except as may be delegated to or modified by the Board of Directors.
  - B. A vacancy in any position may be filled for the unexpired term.

### **ARTICLE V AMENDING THE BYLAWS**

These Bylaws may be amended or revised by a majority at annual meeting

### **ARTICLE VI PARLIAMENTARY AUTHORITY**

The rules contained in Robert's Rule of Order Newly Revised shall govern meetings of the Fund in all cases where they are applicable and in which they do not conflict with these Bylaws.
